Properties of Carboxylic Acids . 1) Strong hydrogen bonding - Polar $C = O$ and $O \hat{a}^{\dagger} H$ make hydrogen bonding occur readily with water and other $RCOOH$ (forms dimers) Boiling points are higher than alcohols of equivalent molecular weight . 2) Acidic behavior: Carboxylic acids readily react with bases to form salts and water:

Carboxylic acids: $R \hat{a}^{\dagger} COOH$ $COOH = \hat{a}^{\dagger} \text{carboxyl group} \hat{a}^{\dagger}$
